

The Prevista Pure washbasin block is suitable for walling in and around, for single mounting, for line mounting, wall mounting, and stand-alone mounting.

2.2.1 Overview




Fig. 1: Components and scope of delivery

- 4 Flushing pipe connector
- 5 Protective plug
- 6 Wall mounting
- 7 Screws for fixing in stud frame



- 8 Screws for fixing in the wall
- 9 Assembly accessories wall plates
- 10 Threaded rods for fixing sanitary objects

2.2.2 Compatible components

The washbasin element is compatible with all common washbasin ceramics, even with larger projection (barrier-free).





Fig. 2: Dimensions




3.2 Assembly


3.2.1 Mounting the washbasin block



■ Break the locking clips off the wall mountings.




- Push the wall mountings into the element.
- Insert the locking clips.




- Adjust the construction height of the washbasin block in accordance with the on-site marking of the upper edge of the finished floor.
- Mark the fixing points.







- Drill the holes.
- Insert the dowels.




- Tighten the washbasin block via the mounting brackets using a fork spanner (sw 10).






Fold the tab forward.






- Insert the washbasin block in the niche.
- Align and screw the washbasin block.

3.2.2 Mounting the drain elbow




- Insert the drain elbow.
- Fasten the drain elbow using the bow.



Attach the protective plug of the drain elbow.




3.2.3 Setting up and bricking in the washbasin block




- Turn in the threaded rods by hand.
- Push the threaded rods into the desired position.

X1: 170-280 mm

- Tighten the nuts of the threaded rods with a fork spanner (size 17).
- Place the protective caps on the threaded rods.




Set the ledge for the wall plates to the desired height.
The ledge for the wall plates can be adjusted by a maximum of 110 mm.



- Set the drain elbow to the desired height.
- Make the water connections.





- Brick in the washbasin block.
- Fill in the free space.



Tile the washbasin block.

3.3 Disposal

Separate the product and packaging materials (e. g. paper, metal, plastic or non-ferrous metals) and dispose of in accordance with valid national legal requirements.
