


Fig. 1: Component overview




Fig. 2: Dimensions


3.2 Assembly

3.2.1 Mounting in Prevista Dry Plus




The two vertical mounting rails, which surround the element, must be open towards the module and have an inner distance of 420 mm.






Secure the element onto the open mounting rail with the slot nuts supplied:


Insert the slot nut into the opening of the module.



Push the slot nut in until it engages.




Set the height of the mounting rail.



Fasten the slot nut.





Set the heights of the element.

3.3 Disposal
