

2.2 Intended use

2.2.1 Areas of application

The Prevista Dry urinal element is suitable for mounting on masonry wall constructions and stud frames pursuant to the regulations in section *Chapter 2.1 'Standards and regulations' on page 5* and can be used in a Prevista Dry Plus pre-wall construction.

2.3 Product description

2.3.1 Overview

The urinal element is equipped as follows:






Fig. 1: Components

- 1 Urinal element
- 2 supply fitting
- 3 pipe clamp
- 4 Screws for fixing in stud frame
- 5 Screws and dowels for fixing in the floor
- 6 Sanitary object fixing
- 7 Plug-in piece
- 8 Seal
- 9 Site protection

The urinal element is compatible with all common urinal ceramics.




2.4 Accessories

3 Handling

3.1 Assembly information

3.1.1 Mounting conditions

Suitable walls

- Masonry walls
- Concreted walls
- Steel stud frame
- Viega Prevista Dry Plus pre-wall constructions

The wall constructions must comply with the regulations in section \Leftrightarrow 'Regulations from section: Fields of application / Mounting conditions' on page 5.


The urinal element may only be mounted on even wall surfaces.

Construction height

The urinal element is suitable for construction heights of 1120—1300 mm.

3.2.1 Mounting the element


Masonry and concrete walls

You should use a Prevista Dry support bracket (model 8570.48) when mounting multiple urinal elements with an interval of > 500 mm. Observe the instructions for use of the support bracket when mounting.


For mounting, Viega recommends to use a Prevista Dry fixing set.



Mounting to a masonry or concrete wall




- Determine and mark the fixing points.
 - X1:
 - with construction height 1120 mm: 1100 mm
 - with construction height 1300 mm: 1280 mm
 - X2: Depending on the fixing set used




- Determine and mark the fixing points on the floor.
 - X3: 375 mm
- Drill the holes.
- Insert the dowels.

INFO! Mount the Prevista Dry fixing set pursuant to the instructions for use for the fixing set.




Loosen the feet of the element using a fork spanner.






- Adjust the construction height of the element in accordance with the on-site marking of the upper edge of the finished floor.
 - X:
 - with construction height 1120 mm: 1000 mm
 - with construction height 1300 mm: 1180 mm
- Tighten the feet of the element using a fork spanner.

➡ The element is attached to the wall.





Mounting in Prevista Dry Plus







Mount the Prevista Dry Plus pre-wall construction pursuant to the instructions for use of the Prevista Dry Plus system.

NOTICE!

When mounting without a continuous rail above the element, the Prevista Dry Plus fixing set (model 8570.49) must also be used. See example with WC element model 8521.




- Position the element on the floor rail.
- Fix the feet on the floor rail using the clips.



Set the height of the element by means of the feet.






Fix the element with the Prevista Dry Plus rail connectors.




□ The element is fixed in the Prevista Dry Plus pre-wall construction.




Mounting in steel stud frame



- Position the element on the floor rail.
- If necessary, adjust the foot depth from 50 mm (pre-mounted) to 75 mm.
- Pull the foot out and turn by 90°.
- Fix the feet.




- Adjust the construction height of the element in accordance with the on-site marking of the upper edge of the finished floor.
 - X:
 - with construction height 1120 mm: 1000 mm
 - with construction height 1300 mm: 1180 mm




Attach the element to the stud frame using the screws supplied.



3.2.2 Mounting the water connection



- Seal the connection end of the urinal water path.
- Screw the threaded end of the adapter elbow and the connection end of the urinal water path.
- Insert the water inlet into the transition angle.
- Press the connection.




Mount the inspection shaft.




3.2.3 Set and clad the element



Use the quick releases to adjust the ledges for drain elbows, supply fittings and urinal fixing to the desired height.




- Turn in the threaded rods by hand.
- Tighten the nuts of the threaded rods with a fork spanner.
- Place the protective caps on the threaded rods.




Mount a drain elbow.





Impress the plasterboard cladding panel at the inspection shaft by applying gentle pressure.

- Cut out the recesses for the drain elbow, the inspection shaft and the threaded rods.



INFO! The maximum wall installation is 60 mm.

Clad the element with suitable plasterboard cladding panels.

3.3 Disposal

Separate the product and packaging materials (e. g. paper, metal, plastic or non-ferrous metals) and dispose of in accordance with valid national legal requirements.
