


Fig. 1: Scope of delivery





Fig. 2: Installation dimensions




3.2 Assembly

3.2.1 Mounting the grate

Preparing the grate




Required width and height of the tiles in mm.
The required surface width is ≤36 mm.



INFO! The flooring height including adhesive up to the upper edge of the recess is 10 mm! Bonding is possible from a flooring height over the upper edge of the recess.


Apply silicone uniformly over grate base.
Apply max. 1 mm of silicone for maximum tile thickness.




Stick the tiles with approx. 1 mm gap at side into the grate and then fill up joint.




Mounting the grate



Remove the site protection.




Fit the sieve insert.



Determine the height required from the shower channel base to the upper edge of the tiles.







- Mount the rubber caps.
- Screw the spacer for the height adjustment of the grate onto the threaded pins.

With nut M5x8 from 6-10 mm.


With nut M5x12 from 8-15 mm.



Set the distance using the threaded feet. For flooring heights from 6-15 mm.




Press on the rubber caps.



Insert the grate and, if necessary, adjust slightly.
For flooring heights greater than 15 mm, use extension set (model497.10)).





Mount the additional threaded feet.

3.2.2 Care



NOTICE! Risk of damage due to unsuitable cleaning

The following cleaning agents can damage chrome-plated surfaces and therefore may not be used:

- Scouring agent
- Abrasive sponges
- Lime, plaster or cement dissolver
- Solvents or other acidic cleaning agents

Normal soap or a mild cleaning agent can be used for regular care and prevention of lime scale. Under no circumstances should scouring agent or scratching objects be used.

Strong stains, even around the drain unit and the siphon, can be removed using typical household cleaner. Please note that the cleaning agent must be rinsed off thoroughly with clear water after the prescribed soaking time. There should be no residue on the components.

3.3 Disposal

Separate the product and packaging materials (e. g. paper, metal, plastic or non-ferrous metals) and dispose of in accordance with valid national legal requirements.
