






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1 About these instructions for use

The Prevista Dry Plus washbasin module is designed for mounting in a Prevista Dry Plus pre-wall construction.

2.2.1 Overview




Fig. 1: Components and scope of delivery

- 1 Washbasin module
- 2 Wall bracket for concealed odour trap
- 3 Screws for fixing in stud frame
- 4 Assembly accessories concealed odour trap
- 5 Slot nuts
- 6 Assembly accessories wall plates
- 7 Threaded rods for fixing sanitary objects



2.2.2 Compatible components

The washbasin module is compatible with all common washbasin ceramics, even with larger projection (barrier-free).



3 Handling

3.1 Assembly information

3.1.1 Mounting conditions

Suitable walls

■ Prevista Dry Plus pre-wall constructions

The washbasin module may only be mounted on even wall surfaces.

Construction height

With the construction height, the marked height of the upper edge of the finished floor must be observed.




Fig. 2: Dimensions




3.2 Assembly

3.2.1 Mounting module

Mounting in Prevista Dry Plus




The two vertical rails, which surround the module, must be open towards the module and have an inner distance of 420 mm.




Secure the module onto the open mounting rail with the slot nuts supplied:

Insert the slot nut into the opening of the module.




Push the slot nut in until it engages.




Set the height of the rail.







Fasten the slot nut.



■ Bend the sides of the metal bars of the rails.




■ Bend the sides of the metal bars of the fitting holder.




Set the height of the module according to the ceramic manufacturer's instructions.




3.2.2 Set and clad the module



Mount an odour trap.




- Turn in the threaded rods by hand.
- Tighten the nuts of the threaded rods with a fork spanner (size 17).
- ▶ Place the protective caps on the threaded rods.
- Make the water connections.



Cut the plasterboard cladding panel to size.





■ Clad the module with suitable plasterboard cladding panels.

3.3 Disposal

Separate the product and packaging materials (e. g. paper, metal, plastic or non-ferrous metals) and dispose of in accordance with valid national legal requirements.
